

## **How to send money internationally with HSBC Global Money Transfers**

Sending money overseas is now even easier.

Simply follow these steps in your HSBC Mobile Banking app.

First of all, open your HSBC Mobile Banking app.

Go to 'Pay & Transfer' at the bottom of the screen.

From here, tap 'Send money internationally'.

Scroll down or search for the country or territory you want to send money to.

Select your transfer method.

Depending on the country or territory you select, you may be given one or more transfer options.

Here, you'll also find estimates for arrival times and transfer fees.

Once you've chosen your preferred transfer method, click 'Continue'.

Next up ... select your 'Global Money Account' and choose your currency.

You'll also need to choose the currency you would like your payee to receive.

Type in the amount of money you'd like to send.

We'll tell you how much your recipient will receive in their local currency.

Currency can be calculated either way around.

When you're done, click 'Continue'.

Add a new payee or choose an existing one.

Select an existing payee from the drop down or click on the '+' to add a new payee.

We'll ask you for several bits of information here.

This will vary depending on the country or territory you're sending money to.

Remember to write your payee's name as it's written on their account.

Adding a payee address can speed things up.

When you're ready, click 'Continue'.

Your next step is to review your payee's information.

Enter a payee name in the 'Payee nickname' box.

Once you're happy everything is right, click 'Confirm'.

Authorise your transfer.

Now your payee is added, reconfirm the amount you'd like to send.

Give the transaction a reference name and click 'Continue' (not mandatory for all countries).

Finally, review your transfer, then click 'Confirm'.

Then click 'Confirm' to complete your transfer.

You're all done!
